

ORDINANCE NUMBER 101221

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL ZONE ON PERRY STREET BETWEEN HWY 155 AND REAGAN STREET AND CROSS WALK LOCATED AT PERRY AND NORTH WELDON STREET TO SCHOOL CAMPUS AND ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT IN THE SCHOOL ZONE ON PERRY STREET AT 15 MILES PER HOUR DURING SCHOOL ZONE HOURS AND ESTABLISHING A FINE FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Frankston has determined that it is necessary to establish a school zone, school crossing, and set a speed limit on Perry Street from Hwy 155 to Reagan Street in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of school children; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Frankston, Texas that:

- 1. That Perry Street between Hwy 155 and Reagan Street in the City of Frankston, Texas, is hereby designated a school zone as defined in the Texas Transportation Code, Section 541.302 (13).
- 2. During the hours of <u>7:10 a.m.</u> o'clock a.m. to <u>3:50 p.m.</u> o'clock p.m., Monday through Friday of each week while the public school is in session, the speed limit in the school zone is set at 15 miles per hour and a school cross walk located at Perry and North Welding Street during the designated times.
- 3. The City Street Department is authorized and instructed to install appropriate traffic control devices to identify the school zone and the speed limit as set forth above. The traffic control devices shall comply with the manual and specifications for uniform traffic control devices as set forth in Section 544.001 of the Texas Transportation Code.
- 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate any vehicle at a rate in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour in the above described school zone between the hours of 7:10 a.m. o'clock a.m. to 3:50 p.m. o'clock p.m., Monday through Friday of any week while public school is in session. Any person who exceeds the speed limit in the school zone set forth above shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200.00 for each separate offense.
