ORDINANCE NO. 11-13-84

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF STATE HIGHWAY NO. 155 FROM MURCHISON STREET TO THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF U. S. HIGHWAY NO. 175; PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF UPRIGHT SIGNS ON EACH SIDE OF SAID STATE HIGHWAY; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That from and after the publication of this ordinance and the erection of the signs described in Section 2 hereof, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle of any kind or character or leave in place any trailer, object or any other form of obstruction within the following area:

BEGINNING where the south right-of-way line of Murchison Street intersects the west right-of-way line of State Highway No. 155;

THENCE along and with the south right-of-way line of Murchison Street as it extends across State Highway No. 155 to where the same intersects the east right-of-way line of State Highway No. 155;

THENCE in a southerly direction along and with the east right-of-way line of State Highway No. 155 to where the same intersects the the north right-of-way line of U. S. Highway No. 175;

THENCE along the north right-of-way line of U. S. Highway No. 175 in a westerly direction to where the same intersects the west right-of-way line of State Highway No. 155;

THENCE in a northerly direction along and with the west right-of-way line of State Highway No. 155 to where it intersects the south right-of-way line of Murchison Street, the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. The City Street Superintendent or his equivalent shall erect not less than $t_{\rm wo}$ (2) signs on each side of State Highway No. 155 at such points as either meet his approval and/or the approval

of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation, which state on their face in standard print that meets state requirements the words "No Parking".

SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction fined not less than \$1.00 and not more than the maximum fine permitted by law.

SECTION 4. It being deemed by the City Council that an emergency does exist, that this ordinance shall go into immediate effect and force after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
