

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6701D, VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES, UPON **BASIS** OF AN **ENGINEERING AND** TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION, UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, OR PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING **ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT** HEREWITH: CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE: PROVIDING A PENALTY: AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.


WHEREAS, Article 6701D, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, provides that whenever the governing body of the City shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of a street or highway within the City, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street or highway, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON, TEXAS:

Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation heretofore made Section 1: as authorized by the provisions of Article 6701D, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, the following prima facie speed limits hereafter indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe; and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the named streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

- 1. From milepoint 0.000, said milepoint being the north city limit of Frankston to milepoint 0.580, a distance of 0.580 mile, the maximum rate of speed shall be 55 mph.
- 2. From milepoint 0.580 to milepoint 1.578, a distance of 0.998 mile, the maximum rate of speed shall be 45 mph, except from milepoint 0.663 to milepoint 0.994, a distance of 0.331 mile, where signed for a school zone when flashing beacons are on, the maximum rate of speed shall be 35 mph
- Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and, in all other respects, the subject matter covered by this ordinance.
- Section 3: If any provision, exception, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance of the application of same to any person or set of circumstances shall for any reason be held unconstitutional, void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances and, to this end, all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
- Section 4: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance or failing to observe any provisions hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding $\frac{2000,00}{200}$.
- Section 5: The great necessity having been found to exist, the rule requiring three readings is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall take effect from and after ten (10) days from its passage by the City Council. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice hereof by causing the caption of this ordinance to be published in the official newspaper of the City of Frankston at least twice within ten (10) days after the passage of this ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6701D, VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES, UPON **TRAFFIC** AND **ENGINEERING** THE **BASIS** OF AN INVESTIGATION, UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, OR PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE; HEREWITH; INCONSISTENT REPEALING **ORDINANCES** CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Article 6701D, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, provides that whenever the governing body of the City shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of a street or highway within the City, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street or highway, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1: Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation heretofore made as authorized by the provisions of Article 6701D, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, the following prima facie speed limits hereafter indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe; and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the named streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

- 1. From milepoint 0.000, said point being the north city limits of Frankston to milepoint 0.580, a distance of 0.580 mile, the maximum rate of speed shall be 55 mph.
- 2. From milepoint 0.580 to milepoint 1.579, said distance being 0.998 mile, the maximum rate of speed shall be 45 mph, except from milepoint 0.794 to milepoint 0.994 where signed for a school zone, the maximum rate of speed shall be 35 mph when flashers are on.


Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and, in all other respects, the subject matter covered by this ordinance.

Section 3: If any provision, exception, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance of the application of same to any person or set of circumstances shall for any reason be held unconstitutional, void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances and, to this end, all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance or failing to observe any provisions hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding
