SECTION 1. That from and after the publication of this ordinance, marking of the designed area, and erection of signage as described in Section 2 hereof, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle of any kind or character or leave in place any trailer, object or any other form of obstruction within the following area;

BEGINNING at the curb line on the Southwest corner of the Frankston City Park on Railroad Street at a reference point even with white line of the Stop sign for traffic going in an East direction at the intersection of Railroad Street and State Highway 155.

THENCE West a distance of 20 feet.

SECTION 2. The City of Frankston shall erect one commercially available sign in an appropriate area with the words "NO PARKING". The curb line in the designated area shall be painted yellow and stenciled with black paint a minimum of two times with the works "NO PARKING".

SECTION 3. Violations and Penalties; any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction punishable by a fine not the exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 4. Effective Date; This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the City Council of the City of Frankston in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.
