AN ORDINANCE CHANGING PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF MAIN STREET FROM STATE HIGHWAY NO. 155 TO THE INTERSECTION OF WELDON STREET: TO PROVIDE FOR PARALLEL PARKING IN SAID BLOCK: PROVIDING FOR THE STRIPPING NECESSARY, PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That from and after the publication of this ordinance and the marking of such parking spaces, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle of any kind or character in any other manner than parallel on the south side of MAIN STREET from State Highway No. 155 to Weldon Street.

SECTION 2. The City Street Department shall mark the parking spaces available at such points to meet the requirements of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction fined not less than \$1.00 and not more than the maximum fine permitted by law.

SECTION 4. It being deemed by the City Council that an emergency does exist, that this ordinance shall go into immediate effect and force after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
