

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT ALL TOILETS AND OTHER PLUMBING FACILITIES BE CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM WHERE SEWER MAINS ARE INSTALLED: REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF SEPTIC TANKS WHERE SEWER MAINS TO NOT EXIST: AND PROHIBITING THE CONSTRUCTION OF OPEN AND PIT-TYPE TOILETS.

WHEREAS, there exists numerous open toilets within the City of Frankston, Texas, which constitute a nuisance to our people and a possible source of contagion; and,

WHEREAS, many additional open toilets are being built which add to this nuisance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRANKSTON, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the construction of open toilets is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2. That all persons utilizing open toilets on property now served by sanitary sewer mains shall be required to install adequate plumbing facilities and connect these facilities to the sanitary sewer system within a period of six months after passage of this ORDINANCE.

SECTION 3. That all persons utilizing open toilets, whose property is within 300 feet of the sanitary sewer mains, shall install adequate plumbing facilities and connect these facilities to the sanitary sewer system within thirty (30) days after sanitary sewer mains are constructed within 300 feet of their property.

SECTION 4. That all future building construction not within 300 feet of the sanitary sewer main shall provide adequate septic tanks for disposition of sewage.

SECTION 5. That it shall be the duty of property owners to comply with the provisions of this ORDINANCE.

SECTION 6. Violators of this ORDINANCE shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$200.00; each day of violation shall constitute a separate offence.

SECTION 7. An emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage and publication.
